When it comes to the question of what to do with a stump, the answer is not always the same. We ask that you weigh the pros and cons of both to decide which option better suits your needs.

Stump Grinding

Pros

- Lower Cost
- Generally faster & less invasive
- Short term solution
- Wood chips can act as natural mulch

Cons

- Leaves a lot of wood chips which can hold disease
- Doesn't fully remove the stump and roots
- Any stump/root left under the surface decomposes overtime
- Decaying root system can grow mold/fungi and become health hazard and/or cause sinkhole in lawn/garden

Stump Removal

Pros

- Removes entire stump and anchoring roots
- Hole filled in with loam so no worry of sink hole
- No excess chips all over garden bed/lawn
- Can easily plant a tree or shrub in same location
- Can install patio/hardscape over previous stump
- Does not inhibit grass growth
- Long term benefit
- No Health Hazards

Cons

- Labor/Time Intensive
- Significantly higher cost
- Generally more invasive
